I refer to your letter dated April 15, 2016, requesting temporary withdrawal of permit application SAS-2007-00388, for the proposed Glades Reservoir Water Supply Project, located on Flat Creek, in Hall County, Georgia.

As requested, your permit application is hereby temporarily withdrawn. Temporary withdrawal of the application requires the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to temporarily suspend further work on preparation of a Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for this project. When Hall County submits information necessary to complete evaluation of this proposed project, the Corps will resume application processing and EIS preparation. Be advised that all applicable law(s) (e.g., new regulations enacted) and/or new relevant data (e.g., changes in population projections), and policies in existence at the time of submittal of your revised application must be incorporated into your application for our evaluation.
